At Abbeyfield & Wesley Housing Association we aim to provide good and loving homes for older people throughout Northern Ireland.

Through our accommodation, care programme and activities, we promote well-being and quality of life. We strive to help overcome the loneliness and insecurity that older people can often feel. We help older people to play an important role amongst their families and friends in their community.

Our staff and volunteers dedicate their time and energies to making everyday a happy one that's also sociable, comfortable, stimulating and safe.

We offer a range of accommodation for people over 55 years of age that includes independent living, supported housing and dementia care homes across Northern Ireland. In total, we help care for around 400 people at 24 properties.



## Can you help us make sure this important work continues into the future?

**If you would like to leave us a gift in your Will we make the following promises:**

- We understand that your family and loved ones come first.
- We will respect your right to privacy and you don't have to tell us your decision (although we'd love to have the opportunity to say thank you).
- We will respect that writing your Will and leaving a legacy gift is a decision you will want to make in your own time - we will never put you under any pressure.
- We will use your gift carefully and ensure it makes a real difference for older people.
- We will share news of the valuable work that is made possible by gifts like yours - overcoming loneliness and making life easier and more fulfilling for our residents and older people in communities throughout Northern Ireland.
- You can change your mind about a gift in your Will to Abbeyfield & Wesley at any time.
- Any gifts you leave will be handled sensitively and respectfully.

## Here's how to proceed if you wish to leave a gift to Abbeyfield & Wesley in your Will:

- Contact your solicitor to tell them you want to make or change your Will to include a gift in cash or kind to Abbeyfield & Wesley Housing Association.
- It is important that you tell your solicitor that the gift is for the benefit of Abbeyfield & Wesley Housing Association, Northern Ireland - registered with The Charity Commission for Northern Ireland NIC106288. Our address is below.
- There are three main types of gift or 'bequest' given by will:
  - **Pecuniary Bequest:** A fixed amount of money.
  - **Specific Bequest:** A valuable item (e.g. an item or a property) owned by you.
  - **Residuary Bequest:** A gift from the residue of your estate after family, friends and debtors have been looked after. Sometimes stated as a percentage.

We respect your right to total privacy and you do not have to tell us about your decision.
